Luther Burbank, an America Botanist and horticulturist, was one of the pioneers of agricultural science. Burbank developed over 800 plant varieties and strains during his 55 years in the field. Although one of his varieties of potatoes became a favorite on the West Coast, he first had to induce his brother to plant it for several year before he saw success. Burbank lived from 1849 – 1926.
